Bornhoffen is a Police-Citizens Youth Club (PCYC) Leadership Development Centre located at Natural Bridge in the Gold Coast hinterland, a spectacular and inspiring setting where you'll feel a world away from the distractions of the city.

Our two **accommodation** centers, known as "Wagawn"& "Hobwee ", are located at our spectacular mountain property & have been named after nearby mountain peaks within the McPherson Ranges. They can be hired individually or as a total venue for large groups.

Bornhoffen PCYC accommodation is one of the best places in SE Queensland for schools, community organisations, special needs groups, churches, clubs and family groups to stay, with the option of healthy and tasty **professional catering** provided by Bornhoffen catering team or kitchen facilities where you can choose **self-catering**.

We work in partnership with schools and community organisations to deliver **Leadership Development programs** that are adventure-based activities, enabling participants to learn through experience and reflection, resulting in personal and group development outcomes. Our program staff are very flexible and will design a program specifically for your development goals, age group and budget.

Bornhoffen PCYC has received a number of awards over the last ten years in recognition of our consistent delivery of excellence in Outdoor Education.

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Leadership Development Programs

PCYC Bronhoffer's purpose is to inspire young people to be self-aware, to build their social skills and to contribute positively to their community.

We form partnerships with schools and community organisations to deliver tailor-made leadership development programs at Bornhoffer or your location in Queensland. We have onsite facilities such as hi-ropes and low-ropes courses, a giant swing, and abseiling. Accommodations

WAGAWN (Camp 1)



Wagawn – perfect for larger groups of 60 to 100 people (Covid-19 safe).

- This facility includes up to 9 bunk style rooms with 12 beds in each (6 x double bunks) – all rooms have 1 x double power point. No bedding or linen provided across facility.
- There are also 3 staff rooms available with 3 single beds in each. In each staff room there is a desk, storage cupboard, 3 x double power points, ensuite shower and toilet. During the Covid-19 pandemic the 4th staff room (S2) is being reserved in case you need an isolation area.
- The facility boasts a large dining room hall, which can double as a hall for recreation / meeting space, a staff lounge area, a second small hall/ meeting room and a commercial kitchen (specify requirements when booking).
- All rooms open onto a verandah and the central courtyard allowing leaders ease of supervision and your whole group located in one building.
- Two amenities blocks (male and female) with 6 showers each. Also 2 wheelchair friendly amenities, with showers.

HOBWEE (Camp 2)



Hobwee – perfect for smaller or family groups of 30 to 72 people (Covid-19 safe).

- This facility includes 8 bunk rooms in 4 cabins. Each cabin has its own deck, which are joined together by central decks & bridges giving covered, shared spaces with great views. Each room has 1 x double power point and an ensuite with shower & toilet. 6 of the bunk rooms have 8 beds (4 x double bunks), and 1 bunk room has 10 beds (5 x double bunks), the final bunk room has 12 beds (6 x double bunks). No bedding or linen provided across facility.
- There are 2 staff rooms with 2 single beds in each. These 2 rooms share a lounge area with bar fridge, 1 double power point and ensuite with shower and toilet.
- There is a large dining room hall which can also be used as a recreation or meeting space, washup room / laundry, and a commercial kitchen.

The Pavilion

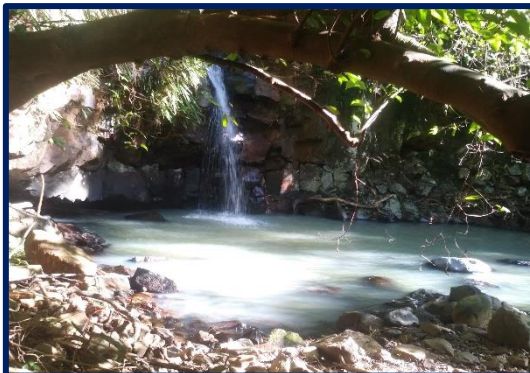

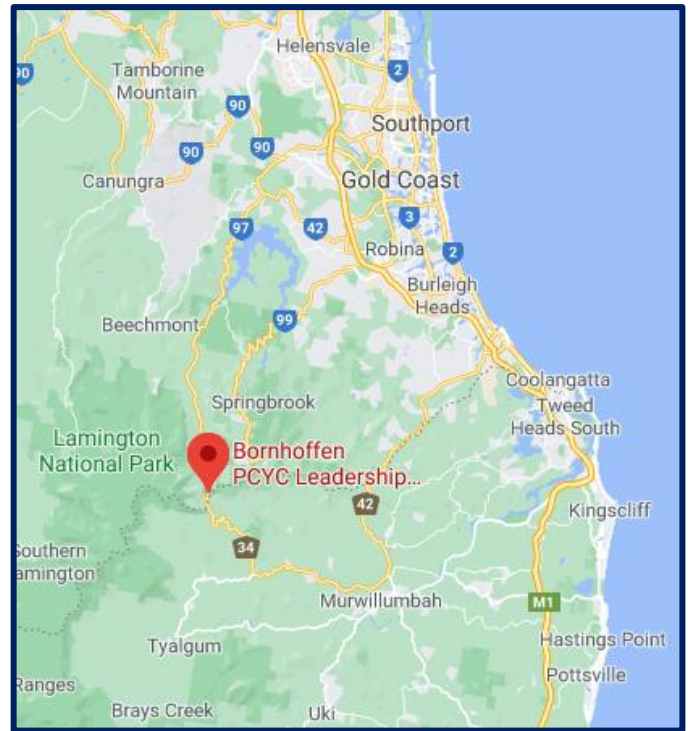
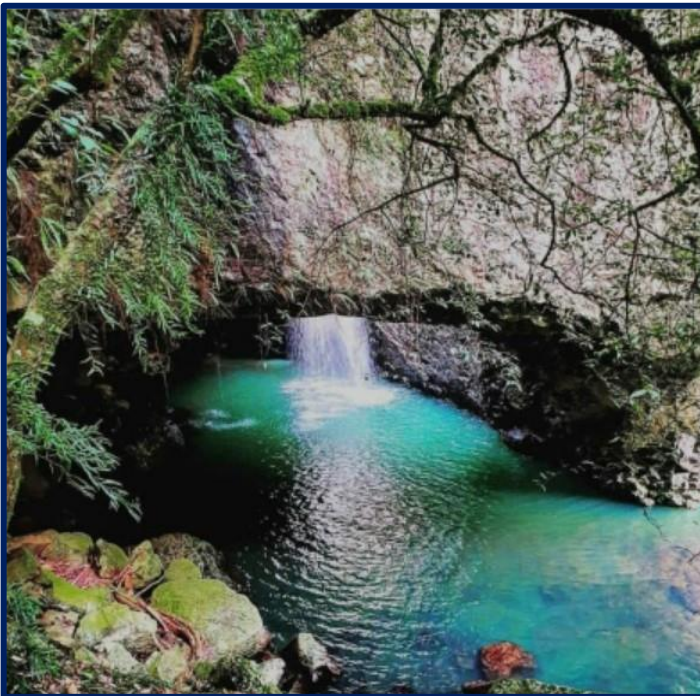

Location

Bornhoffen PCYC is in the Gold Coast hinterland, nestled between World Heritage listed Springbrook and Lamington National Parks. Set amongst stunning natural scenery, we pride ourselves on caring for the land by restoring habitat for native flora and fauna, working with the local community to plant native trees and control environmental weeds. We provide detailed signage throughout the venue about the local environment and cultural heritage. Other ways we aim to reduce our ecological footprint is through recycling and waste reduction and community support and engagement.



Natural Bridge Information

With its fascinating geology, ancient flora and exceptional fauna, Springbrook National Park is a popular place for school excursions. Springbrook plateau is a remnant of the northern side of a once huge shield volcano that dominated the region about 23 million years ago. Over time, the volcano has eroded away, leaving a landscape flush with cool rainforests, open eucalypt forests and montane heaths. This is a place of Antarctic beech trees, blue spiny crayfish, waterfalls and lyrebirds, a place where generations of school students have learnt about the natural environment and will hopefully continue to do in the future.

The Natural Bridge cave is the home of Queensland's most spectacular glow-worm colony, *Arachnocampa flava*. Found along the vertical banks beside the walking track and within the cave that forms the Natural Bridge, glow-worms can be seen in the park all year round after sunset. Other common sights in the park depending on the season include fireflies, luminescent fungi, red-necked pademelons and bandicoots.

There is an on-line form to notify Queensland Parks and Wildlife Services (QPWS) of any group activity you wish to undertake in one of Queensland's national parks, marine parks, recreation areas or state forests in a way that effects the enjoyment of the place by the general public.
